Overview

- Candidates annual Family income should be Upto 8 lakhs
- Candidates admitted to Diploma/Degree / Post graduate professional courses having 60% or more marks and family annual income less than or equal to 6 lakh are eligible for this scholarship

Benefits

1) for professional course, if Income is up to Rs.2,50,000/- Applicant will get benefit of tuition fees(For Govt course-100%, For non-govt aided course-100%, for Partially aided courses-50%, for Permanent unaided course-50%)

2)for professional course, if Income is between Rs.2,50,000/- to Rs.8,00,000/- Applicant will get benefit of tuition fees(For Govt course-50%, For non-govt aided course-50%, for Partially aided courses-50%, for Permanent unaided course-50%)

3)for non- professional course, if Income Up to Rs.8,00,000/- Applicant will get benefit of tuition fees(For Govt course-100%, For non-govt aided course-100%, for Partially aided courses-100%, for Permanent unaided course-100%)

4)for Professional course, if Income Upto Rs.8,00,000/- Applicant will get benefit of Exam fees(For Govt course-50%, For non-govt aided course-50%, for Partially aided courses-50%, for Permanent unaided course-50%).

5)for Non- Professional course, if Income Upto Rs.8,00,000/- Applicant will get benefit of Exam fees(For Govt course-100%, For non-govt aided course-100%, for Partially aided courses-100%, for Permanent unaided course-100%).

Eligibility

(As Per GR Dated 7.10.2017 & 31.3.2018)

- Income Certificate less than 8 lakh.
- Students should have Annual income certificate issued from Tahsildar.
- As per govt resolution first two children eligible for the scheme.
- Courses from GR 07/10/17 (DHE courses) can apply.
- Applicant should be Domicile of Maharashtra.
- Applicant should not avail any other scholarship or stipend.

- Minimum 50 % attendance in previous semester (Exception for fresh admitted in College).
 - During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 years.
 - Only Maharashtra State and Karnataka state border (Only District Belgaum) can apply for this scheme. Students studying Out of Maharashtra cannot apply for this scheme.

- Students should have Annual income certificate issued from Tahsildar.

- Applicants Domicile certificate.
- Attendance Certificate with 50 % percentage form Concern College.
- Receipt of Exam Fees.
- Previous year Marksheet.
- CAP Related document.(only for B.ed, Law, BPed, MPed).
