Rules for the Debate Competition:

- Competition will be conducted in English, Hindi, and Marathi.
- Student's entry only on the basis of Valid I Card
- Each college can send max. 3 entries (teams), 1 for each language.
- Students' entries will be allowed in pairs (1 – for and 1 – against).
- Time limit for each participant is 5 minutes.
- Students will be evaluated on the basis of content, reasoning, confidence and presentation.
- The decision of the judges will be final.
- Cash prizes will be awarded.
