






65% students find that the syllabus is relevant but 78% students feels that the syllabus is very lengthy and cannot be completed in time. 49% students feel that the syllabus will help them to get ready for employment in industry. 80% of students feel that this syllabus covers all the current challenging issues. 73% students feel that they need more learning resources to understand the syllabus in a better way. 50% students feel that the syllabus helps to build confidence in them to face employment in industry. 67% students have expressed that it is difficult for all the levels of students to understand the syllabus. 63% students have agreed that the syllabus should be updated at frequent intervals.









