


Feedback on Current Syllabus 2017-18 Analysis Report


I. Students Feedback for Review of Syllabus


II. Teachers Feedback on Current Syllabus




The opinion of the faculty on current syllabus is taken from all faculty members including visiting faculties. A structured questionnaire was given to them for the purpose of response.

The responses received from the respondents are presented as follows:










The data was collected with the help of a structured questionnaire. Respondents include - Bank Officer, Business, Farmer, Housewife, Professor, Service, and employee.


