



Feedback on Current Syllabus 2018-19 Analysis Report

Number of Respondents: 240


II. Teachers Feedback on Current Syllabus

Number of Respondents: 25


The opinion of the faculty on current syllabus is taken from all faculty members including visiting faculties. A structured questionnaire was given to them for the purpose of response.




IV.Parents Feedback on Current Syllabus


The data was collected with the help of a structured questionnaire. Respondents include - Bank Officer, Business, Farmer, Housewife, Professor, Service, and employee.


