






Analysis :


The responses of students were taken and analyzed, 83% felt syllabus relevant but 27% do not agree. It is lengthy according to 67% still completed on time but 32%-33% feel it requires extra lectures. Nearly 58%-62% feel it does not help in employability or solve real life issues and 86% agree the syllabus should be updated regularly where as 14% did not agree. The 85% expressed the need to have experts to teach but 15% were not on favor of it. Nearly 67% feel it is understandable by students of all levels and nearly 80% feel is value based education but 20% do not agree to it.




Analysis :

89% of the teachers are in favor of syllabus revision at regular intervals and teachers should be trained continuously to teach it but only 2-3% teachers disagreed. Even large majority (85%) is in favor of providing notes to students and use ICT while teaching. There are 83% teachers who agree the syllabus to be relevant for the learners. The syllabus is understandable by all levels and 87% teachers put extra efforts for both slow learners and advanced learners .But 7% feel we can do some specific aids for slow learners. Nearly 25% Teachers expressed syllabus lengthy but 75% disagree to it and can be finished on time .Nearly 82% of the teachers felt it is relevant and the experts from the industry are welcomed. Only 14% teachers are I the syllabus formation committee at University level. 78% feel it imparts value education but 12% do not find it so.


Analysis :

The students who are now employed and some are doing higher studies out of it 91% agreed that the ambience at Vivek College provides an atmosphere to achieve academic excellence. The institutional facilities are student –centric expressed by 84% the remaining 16% do not find so. As it is prescribed by the University 78% felt it helped them to get employment at initial stages, the remaining 22% want upgrade with time making it more employment–oriented. 





Analysis :






