NSS ACTIVITIES DURING ACADEMIC YEAR 2016-2017

A) COMMUNITY BASED PROJECTS -

Under community based projects, NSS Volunteers participated in total 08 projects.

1. TEACHING IN OPEN BALWADI IN BHAGAT SINGH NAGAR:

As Bhagat Singh Nagar is adopted area of college NSS Unit, our NSS volunteers taught 5th to 10th std. students for 02 hours every day. Our volunteers taught them subjects like Science, Mathematics, Geometry, History, Moral values etc. This project was conducted throughout the year. NSS Volunteers also celebrated Diwali with children of open balwadi.

2. PUNARVAS:

Punarvas is a school for physically and mentally challenged children in Goregaon west. This project was selected to sensitize NSS Volunteers about physically and mentally challenged children. Under this project following activities were conducted:

- a. Our NSS Volunteers helped teachers and students for 02 hours in their daily activities thrice a week. NSS volunteers also helped them in making various articles like Rakhis & Diwali Diyas.
- b. NSS Volunteers sold total 98 Rakhis made by children of Punarvas from 8th to 16th August, 2016.
- c. NSS Volunteers sold Diwali Diyas made by children of Punarvas from 13th to 18st Oct., 2016 in college premises as well as in their residential areas. Volunteers sold Diyas of amount Rs. 4,105/-

3. GANPATI IMMERSION

NSS volunteers helped Traffic control department and Goregaon Police Station on 2nd day, Gauri visarjan (5th Day), 7th Day and Ananth Chaturdashi (10th day) of Ganpati Immersion in month of September, 2016. Volunteers helped in crowd control at Aarey Colony, Bangur Nagar and Jogeswari (East).

4. WASTE MANGEMENT:

On 23rd Sept 2016 NSS Unit of Vivek College organized a session on 'Waste Management'. The team of Stree Mukti Sanghatna came for the session and provided their valuable guidance to our 45 NSS volunteers.

NSS unit started with the project of wet waste management of canteen in association with Stree Mukti Sangathna. We have kept 2 waste recycling plastic baskets in which canteen wet waste is disposed off for converting it into manure. Under this project we aim at reducing the wet waste going to dumping ground.

We have also collected 20kgs. of e-waste from the students and college which was sent for recycling.

5. ROAD SAFETY PROJECT

This project was undertaken with the motive of sensitizing the volunteers towards Traffic rules and Road Safety. Under this project following activities were conducted:

- a. This year we have adopted Sadguru Naka at S.V. Road Goregaon (West). Our NSS volunteers helped Traffic Control Dept., at Sadguru Naka, Goregaon (West) in traffic control from 8th July,2016 to 11th Jan., 2017 from Monday to Saturday.
- b. On 19th Dec, 2016, a session was conducted by Mr.Jadhav Senior Police Inspector Traffic Control Division Malad West on Road Safety and Traffic Rules.
- c. Road safety rally was organized in the Siddharth Nagar and Jawahar Nagar area as per the guidelines of RTO office Malad on 10th January, 2017. Volunteers of J. M. Patel College, Dalmia College, Lord's College participated in the rally. Total 163 Volunteers participated in the Road safety rally.

- d. NSS unit organized session on road safety in-collaboration with United Way- a NGO actively working for Road Safety. 35 Volunteers attended the session on 11th January, 2017. The volunteers were guided and trained under this session about road safety measures.
- e. 6 Volunteers Participated in Traffic Ambassador Training organized by Traffic Control Department, Malad from 5th January, 2017 to 9th January, 2017.
- f. On 8th February 2017, a 'Road Safety Kiosk' was set up in our college by United Way. Road Safety awareness was created among the students in the kiosk through various games. Our 10 volunteers helped in managing the event.
- g. On 13th February, 2017 NSS Volunteers participated in the street play competition which was organized by the United Way. Volunteers performed street play on '**Two Wheel One Life**'. Vivek College Secured 1st Rank at Zonal level and Consolation Prize at Mumbai Level.

6.YOGA CLUB:

NSS unit of Vivek College has started with Yoga Club in association with Ambika Yog Kutir. Every Sunday our volunteers went to Ambika Yoga Centre, Goregaon to learn yoga from 7am to 9am. 40 Volunteers completed Basic Course in Yoga.

7.PULSE POLIO IMMUNISATION:

NSS volunteers helped the Health Department, BMC in Pulse polio Campaign at Goregaon railway station from 24^{th} to 30^{th} September 2016. Total beneficiaries were 303.

From 29th January to 3rd February, 2017, the campaign was conducted at Goregaon station, Ram Mandir station and in the area of Cama Estate. Total beneficiaries of the campaign were 493.

8. HEALTH PROJECT

Under Health Project following activities were conducted:

- a. In the month of August, every Sunday our NSS volunteers helped BMC Officials from Health department of P/S ward in health camp at Bhagat Singh Nagar. In this camp free checkups of Blood Pressure, Hemoglobin, Diabetes, Eye Check-up etc. was organised.
- b. Guest lecture on Dengue Malaria awareness was organized in association of BMC Health Dept., P/S ward on 30th August, 2015. Officers from Health Department enlightened the students about causes of and precautions to be taken for Dengue Malaria.

- c. On 5th October 2016, Our NSS unit organised Bone density checkup for the Staff of Vivek Education Society in association with Lions Club Malad. 5 volunteers helped to manage the event. Total beneficiaries were 125.
- d. On 28th November 2016, our NSS Unit organised Hemoglobin Checkup for girl students and female staff members in association with Lions Club Malad. Total numbers of beneficiaries were 198.
