- Additions during the academic – added 3228 books to the collection costing Rs.6,27,366. Subscribed to 102 periodicals costing Rs 1,84,252.
- 18 Newspapers are procured in six languages ie. English, Hindi, Marathi, Gujarathi, Tamil, Malayalam to keep the students updated with latest information.
- We subscribe to Nlist Database if INFLIBNET which provides access to 6000+ E-Journals and more than 97000 E-Books.
- News Clipping are displayed on the library notice board relating to education, career, science, technology etc. to keep the students abreast of the latest information and are maintained subject wise in separate files for reference.
- Eight computers are used by the students in the Research centre for their academic needs. Printout facility is available at concessional rate.
- Computer with library catalogue at the entrance of the Library helps students in knowing the titles available in the College Library. Web OPAC catalogue also available through college website.
- 11 Ex-students have enrolled for Library membership during this academic year.
- Back volumes of journals are available for current issue.

### **Activities Conducted**

1. Library orientation was held for the first year students of all classes to acquaint them with the functioning of the library.
2. Book Bank facility is extended to 138 economically weak students from FYBCOM,SYBCOM &TYBCOM classes. Books are issued to the selected students which should be returned after the semester end exam.
