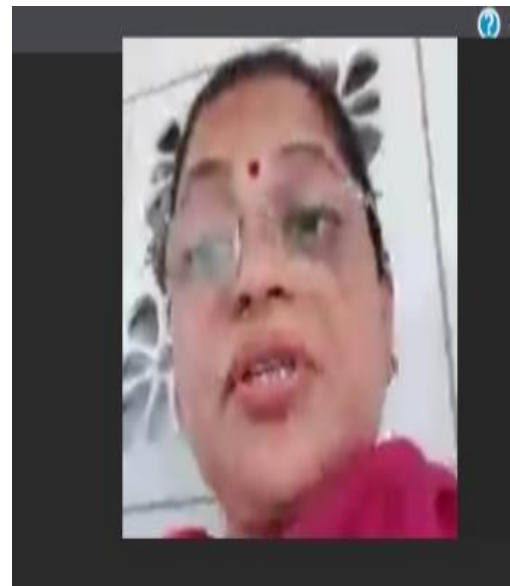
Under this, Book Review and Poem Recitation Competitions, the Kathakathan program, and workshops on Marathi Writing and Online Platform were organized.
