## **Activities organized**


1. We observed the **Punyathithi of Swami Vivekananda** on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2021. On this day, Swami Vivekananda became one with God, while in a state of meditation after living his day like any other and teaching his followers and discussing the teachings with Vedic Scholars went to his room in the Ramakrishna Math, the monastery he built in honour of his Guru to meditate and breathe his last. His followers believed the cause of death to be the rupture of a blood vessel in his brain that happens when one attains nirvana, the highest form of spiritual enlightenment when the 7th chakra that is the crown chakra which is located on the head opens and then gains Maha samadhi while meditating. The time of his death was 9:20 pm. He was cremated on a sandalwood funeral pyre on the banks of the Ganga opposite his guru.





2. **Vivek Deekshaarambh** for the First-year students was conducted on the 6<sup>th</sup>,7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> of September 2021 aiding with induction, to acquaint them with the culture and values, and activities of our college. The purpose of the Deeksharambh - the student Induction Programme was to help new students adjust and feel comfortable in the new environment, inculcate in them the ethos and culture of the institution, help them build bonds with other students and faculty members, and expose them to a sense of larger purpose and self-exploration. The event was a massive hit among the first years who thoroughly enjoyed themselves.

On the first day, the first years were given a glimpse of the college, addressed by the principal
and the management, shown around the website, and talked about the Internal Quality
Assurance Cell (IQAC). They were also trained on how to the Microsoft Teams for the lectures.



• On the 2<sup>nd</sup> day, the first years were told about the committees at the college such as the National Service Scheme (NSS), the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE), Sports and Gymkhana, Yuva club, Rotaract club, and other cultural activities. They were also taught about student support, Scholarships, Bonafide, and online applications.



• On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day they were shown how the college is governed and talked about the attendance, Discipline, and Examinations for the aided and self-financing section and the library.



• On the 4<sup>th</sup> and last day, they were told about the language course in English and Sanskrit, Japanese, German, etc, along with Yoga, the Swayam certificate courses, and Tally ERP. They were also told about the workshops, E-Cell, Career and Placement Cell, the bridge course for Maths, and the Research Cell.


