





12. Vivek Youth Club-Samarth Yuva Camp

Four days of residential Samarth Yuva Camp were conducted at Pimplad Village in Nashik District from 1st to 4th May 2022. Twenty-five students participated in the camp. Our camp preparation started 10 days before the camp and orientation was held on 29th April at college. The main objective of the camp was to help young students to establish an eagerness to learn, develop life skills strengthen decision-making and problem-solving skills, improve communication skills strengthen self-esteem increase leadership ability practice time management skills, build positive relationships with adults, and connect with the rural community.

Main Activities

- Inauguration of the camp by Ms. Sujatha Dalvi Vivekanand Kendra Maharashtra Pranth Sangatak.
- Our days started at 6 am every day with morning prayer, singing spiritual songs, exercising, performing yoga, and Surya namaskar for the mental and physical development of the students.
- Training On Bhakti Geeth and Gaming activity. many games were organized to develop the intellectual spiritual emotional potentials of the students. Students played innovative and interesting games such as **sher and bakri** (**lion and goat**) and **Ram and Rayan**.
- PPT on "Born to Succeed" &various topics on challenges faced by today's youth and social awareness oriented were presented to train our student's presentation skills.

- Students were given group activities on **different topics to train their presentation** skills
