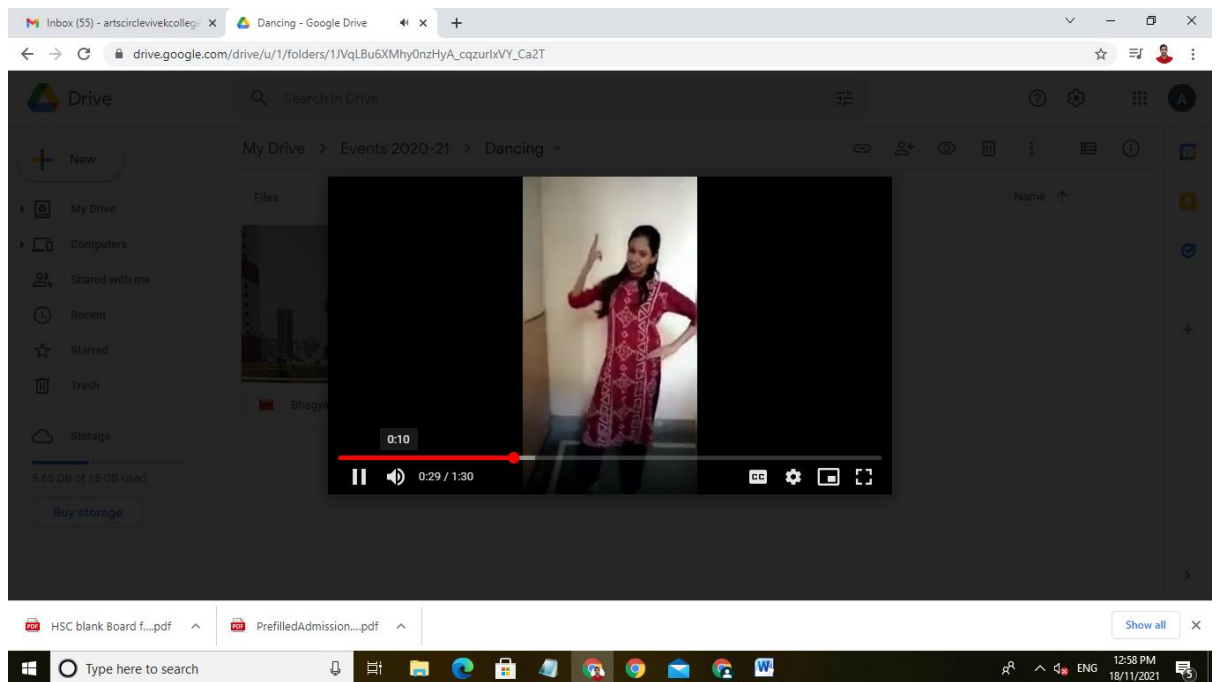
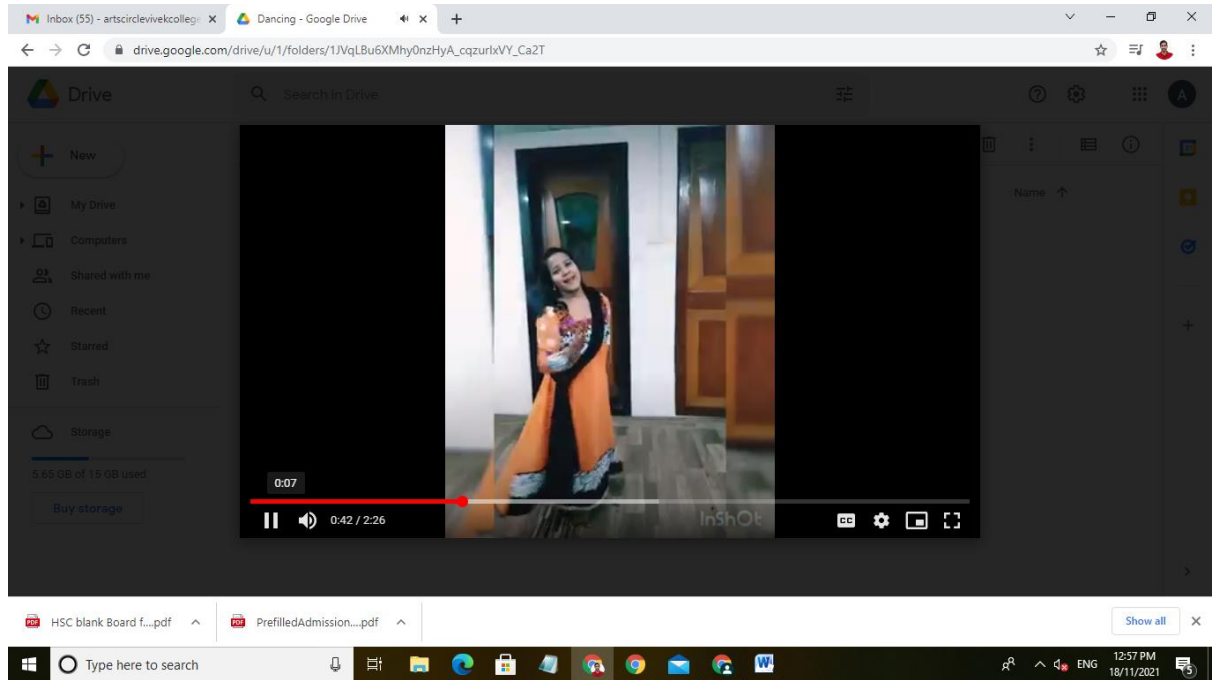

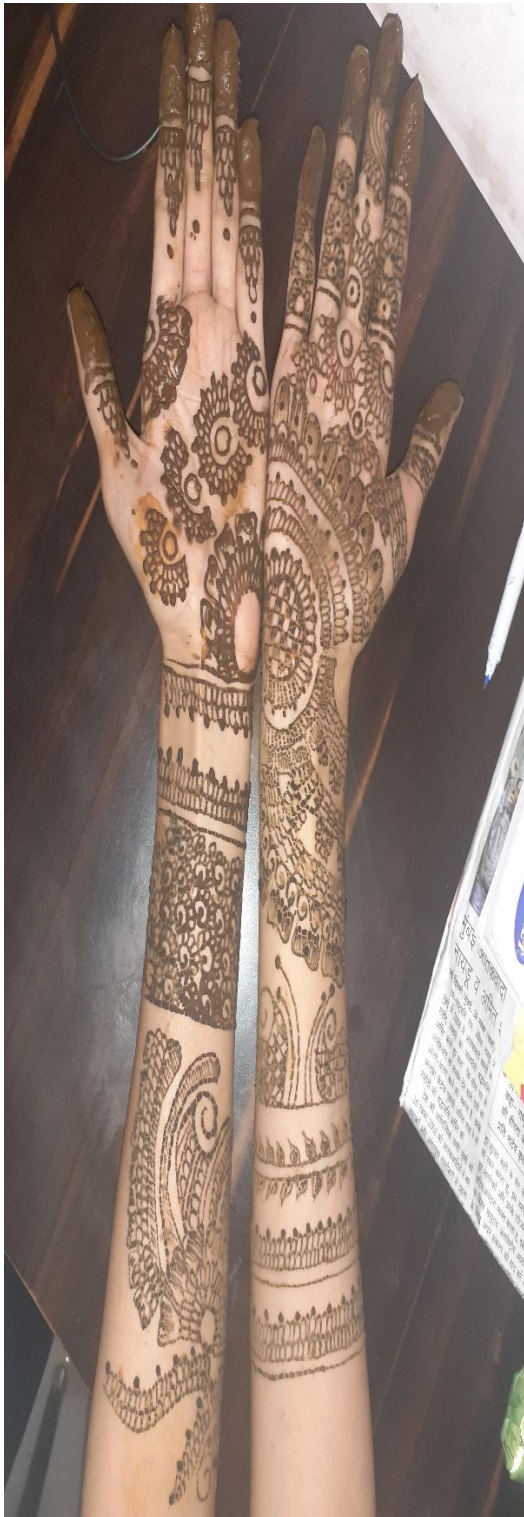
Someone has rightly said, "Give me the children and I will change the nation."

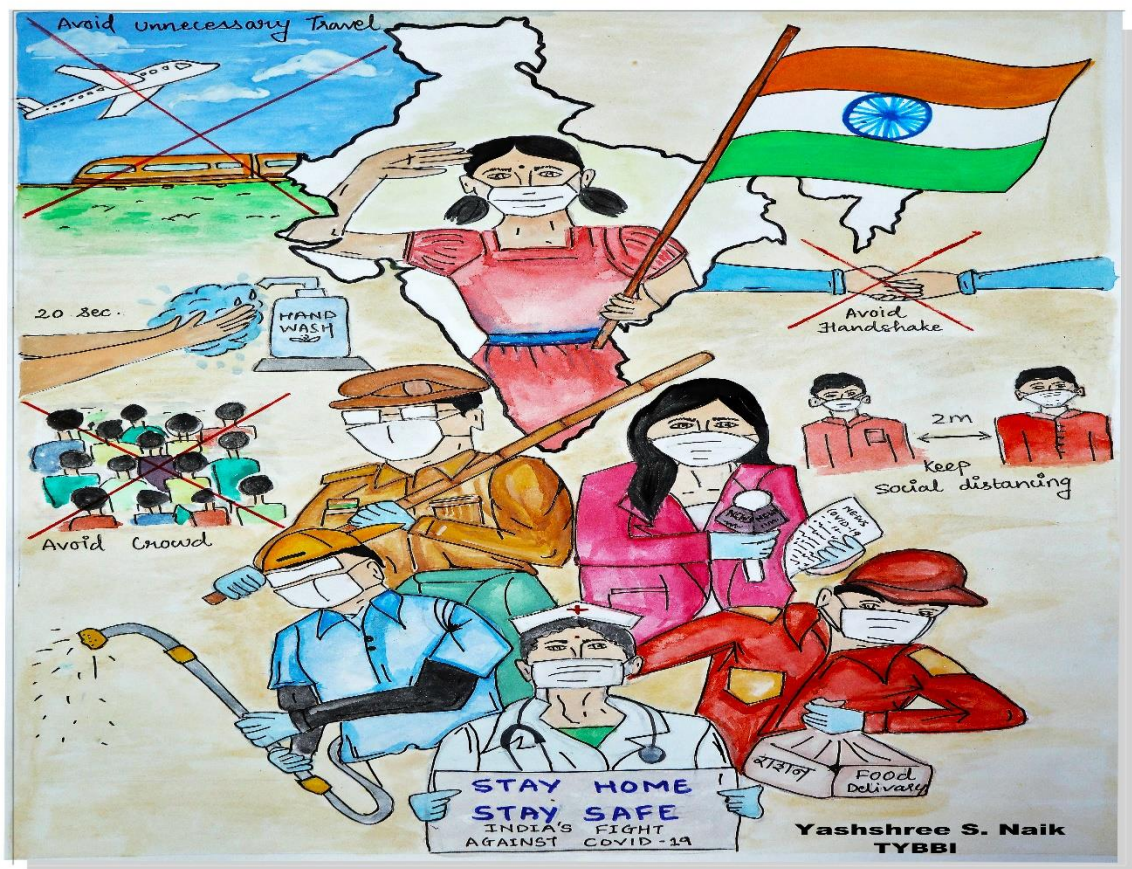
Students can do a lot in realising this dream and making India technically sound as they have a natural instinct about the latest technology and its use.

The youth will have to be morally, mentally and physically sound and acknowledge the fact that hard work is the only key to success. They should take effective steps to eradicate social evils from our society in

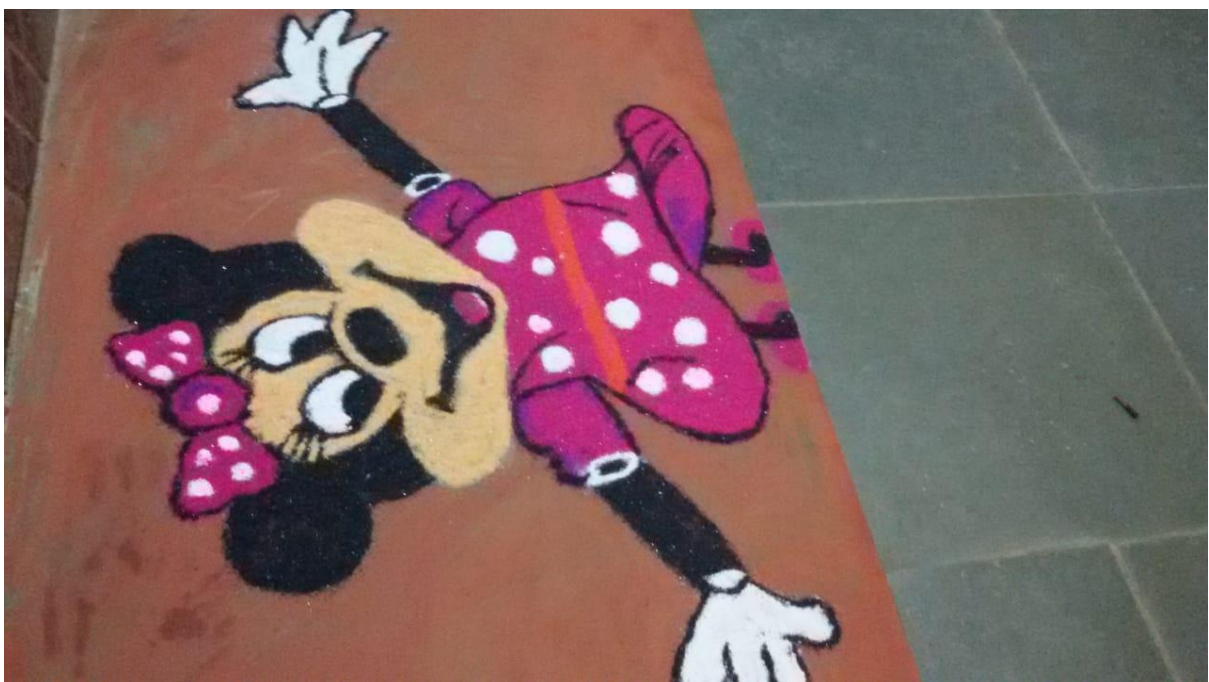
