Under the initiative of IQAC in association with the Student Council, a session was organized for staff and students on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation as a life-saving skill to help our students and staff.

On 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022, the session was held for students and on 22<sup>nd</sup> September the session was held for the staff members.

Dr. Shifa Dalwai from SRV Hospital addressed the audience and gave a background on Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation. They made the audience aware of the concept of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation with PPT presentations and Video clips. They explained the difference between cardiac arrest and Heart attack, the causes, and the steps of first aid.

A training session was also provided during the session with the help of a mannequin they showed a live presentation for better understanding.

The audience got a live experience of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation therapy and the steps for first aid.

College non-teaching staff, support staff, and security attended fire safety training under the direction of Health and Safety. A fire Drill was conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2022 at the stilt area of the institution.

The training was provided to our staff. As part of the training, staff received instructions on how properly we can use a fire extinguisher based on the type of fire. Trainers advised the audience to take time to familiarize themselves with the locations of fire exits, fire extinguishers, and pull-alarm stations. Tampering with fire extinguishers can leave us unprotected in case of a fire. Please remember, false alarms could reduce the response of residents when a fire occurs.
