WDC report of the activities:

The college has a Women Development Cell which is constituted as per the guidelines of the University of Mumbai. The Women Development Cell functions accordingly and organizes programs for students and staff every year for creating sensitization on gender-related issues in consultation with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college.

The following is the list of activities organized in the year 2022-23:

1. Session on Initiative on Gender Awareness for Boys

A session on 'Initiative on Gender Awareness for Boys' was organized on 7th July 2022 in association with IQAC and Hindustan Unilever Ltd. to educate the boys on personal grooming. Mr.Swapnil Shinde, a trained counsellor spoke on the importance of personal hygiene and personal habits. He insisted upon the need to take care of one's physical self, feelings, and thoughts. He emphasized that youngsters must carefully monitor four points for Confidence-building: spending time in a constructive way, Time Management, dietary habits, spending time with near and dear ones, and leading a balanced way of life. His message was to avoid excess of everything in life. A total of 138 male students attended the session.

Ms. Charu Malhotra emphasized that there is a biological difference between the two genders and in the current scenario we need to maintain gender equity.

Ms. Sangeeta Desai highlighted that to achieve the goal of women's empowerment in digital India, more women should engage in IT services. Dr. Vibhuti Patel moderated the

entire panel discussion. A total of 26 students along with Dr. Neelu Khosla attended the session.
