- To have a thorough insight into all techniques of information handling with special emphasis on the application of information technology

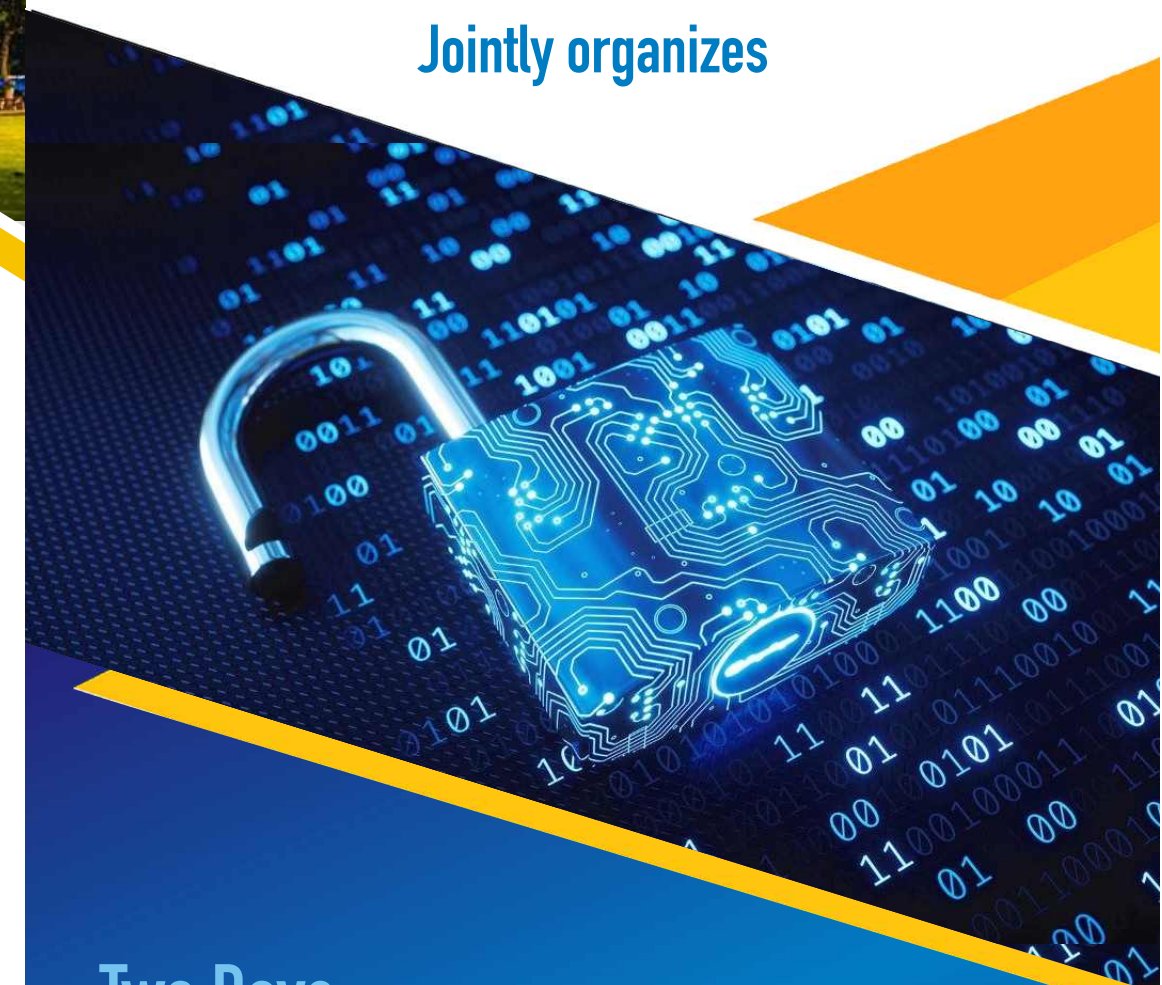
